

# Trillium Woods Campground Rules & Regulations

PLEASE respect your fellow campers at all times.
DRIVE SLOWLY (Maximum 10km/h).
WATCH FOR CHILDREN & CYCLISTS.

- ➤ QUIET TIME: 11 pm 8 am.
  - o Gates are locked @ 10 pm and opened @ 7 am.
  - <u>radio-free park At any time</u>, day or night, tablets, phones, computers, radios, TV'S, etc. can only be played inside your camping unit at a volume which cannot be heard outside. Campers are here to enjoy nature's sounds.
  - o Turn off all decorative and flood lights by 11 pm.
- > SITES: Check in is after 2pm and before 8pm. Check out is 12pm (noon).
  - Occupants per site: A maximum of one family or 2 adults per site and one trailer/camping unit is allowed.
  - All sites are restricted to ONE CAR / SITE.
  - Please leave the sites as you find them. Do not dig holes, trenches or dig vegetation. Remove cloth lines when you leave.
  - o Picnic tables are not to be removed from sites. No hibaches on tables.
  - ALCOHOL MUST be consumed at your own campsite in accordance with the provincial laws. No open alcohol in any public areas (beach, road ways, bathrooms, etc).
- > Smoking of Cannabis is prohibited on TWC property. Cannabis shall not be cultivated, produced or distributed anywhere on TWC property, the Site or in your trailer.
- > NO fireworks or firearms in the park.
- > CHILDREN: You are responsible for your children at all times in this campground.
  - o All children under 10 must be accompanied by an adult in the washrooms/showers.
  - Children are to be supervised at the playground & beach at all times by a watchful adult. Swim at your own risk.
  - No loitering or using playground equipment after dark.
  - Children are to be back at their own site by 10 pm.
- ➤ NO Cycling or Swimming AFTER SUNSET.
  - All cyclists must follow provincial law obey rules of the road, under 18 yrs must wear approved helmets and only one person on single bike at a time. Watch for pedestrians and pets.
- ➤ PETS: Remain on a leash and controlled at all times. The pet owner is responsible for pets making excessive noise and disturbing others and should not be left unattended at any time.
  - Please pick up (stoop & scoop) after your PET. (Poop collection pails @ office, beach, & main washrooms).
  - Dogs allowed on posted area at beach, please follow posted rules on bulletin board in front of main washrooms.
  - Pets are not allowed in the washrooms.

- > BATHROOMS: Please keep them clean. No Dishwashing inside bathroom.
- FIRES: Fires are permitted at campsites in fire-pits only. Fire pits are not to be moved.
  - Never leave fires unattended. Douse them with water before leaving or going to bed for the night.
  - Firewood is NOT allowed to be brought into camp, due to ash emerald borer and other harmful insects in trees in other parts of Ontario, without the consent of the owners.
  - Firewood is sold from the store only no leaves, brush or garbage. We do not permit wood gathering from our bush – leave it there and let nature take its course.
- ➤ EMERGENCY Call 911 address is 129 Bryant St. Oliphant, then call office and notify them of emergency situation so they can direct responders to scene quickly.

## **➤ WILDLIFE / NATURE:**

- Do not cut trees or branches, peel bark or drive nails into trees. This will kill the tree.
- o Anyone abusing wildlife in the park will be evicted.
- o Do not leave any birdfeeders, food or garbage out (may attract bears & raccoons).
- o Beware, there is poison ivy in the bush.

#### > VISITORS:

- o All visitors to the camp must register on arrival, and park in the front parking lot.
- o Day visitors must leave the park by 10 pm or will be charged an overnight fee.
- Registered campers are responsible for their visitor's behavior in the park and any fees, which have not been paid.

### MOTORCYCLES / ATV's:

o are not permitted to roam in the park. If you arrive on a road bike, it may be ridden to your site and parked until your departure.

## ▶ DO NOT LITTER – Cigarette butts into outdoor ashtrays - NOT ON THE GROUND

- ➤ **RECYCLE/ COMPOST:** Glass, plastic, paper and cardboard can be sorted and placed in marked **recycling blue bins** beside red garbage trailer.
  - There are 7 green Composter cones for household waste located on sites: 2, 11,16,46,58, road to rec hall & garbage area. – No Meat products please!

#### > GARBAGE:

- After you recycle and compost, please place garbage in a SECURED <u>CLEAR</u>
   BAG and deposit into red garbage trailer.
- o Is for household garbage only. Large items to be taken to landfill or home.
- o YOU BRING IT, YOU TAKE IT HOME.
- Management accepts no responsibility for personal properties left at the beach and anywhere in the campground, including injury from whatever cause.
- Willful damage or non-compliance with rules or regulations of the park will result in expulsion from the park without refund at the manager's discretion.
